Summer Reading Challenge 2022

Summer at the library is a two part family adventure! One part is a 6 week challenge where children read to earn prizes. The second part of our adventure is our free 6 week set of classes.

Beginning Saturday, June 4, children ages birth-8th grade with valid AMP library card may register for the prize program. You may register any time during the summer, June 4-July 30, but please be aware that supplies may be limited. Prizes can start to be collected beginning Monday, June 20. All programs and classes are free to Youth District card holders. Please phone the Patron Services desk for more information concerning how to get a library card. Reciprocal card holders and Non-residents are not eligible for this program.

How does the Summer Reading Prize program work?

This year the prize program will run for 6 weeks beginning Saturday, June 4. Beginning Monday, June 20th, children “check-in” any time we are open to receive a coupon and small toy. You check-in when it’s convenient for you! We will also enter all participants in weekly raffles and a special Grand Prize family activity membership.

How do the programs work?

Programs will be on a first come, first serve basis starting Monday, June 20. We have a limited number of space so we suggest arriving at least 15 minutes before the program begins. It would also be a great help if each child had their library card out and ready. The programs are available to each child that has their own valid AMP library card.

Option 1) Applicants or parent/legal guardian (if applicant is under 18) are asked to **show a picture ID** indicating their name and current address. In addition, they are asked to show **one other form of identification** with the same name and current address from the pre-approved items listed below.

Option 2) If the picture ID does not contain a current district address, then **two (2) other items** containing the same name and district address must be presented.

The pre-approved list includes:

Utility Bill

Lease

Mortgage Payment Book

Current Vehicle Sticker Registration

Current Vehicle Registration Identification

Auto Insurance Card

Voter's Registration Card

Current Firearms ID

Current State of IL Medical Statement

Current College Semester Schedule

All items must be current and show a district address.

Please Note: The library district and our school districts boundaries are not the same.

Chicago patrons with a valid CPL card may apply for a reciprocal AMP library card. The card provides limited borrowing privileges,

as set by Chicago Public Library.

Persons desiring a library card for themselves or for their children must provide personal information to be entered electronically online along with an electronic signature agreeing to the following:

- 1) to be responsible for all materials checked-out on the card;
- 2) to be responsible for any charges (including collection agency fees) that may result from late return, loss or damage to materials borrowed;
- 3) to comply with the local library and Reaching Across Illinois Library System (RAILS) regulations.

In the case of a minor under 18, the parent's/legal guardian's signature is also required. This signature indicates:

- 1) assumption of financial responsibility for materials checked out on the minor's card;
- 2) awareness of the fact that there are no restrictions on borrowing any library materials EXCEPT AV materials;
- 3) acceptance of the responsibility of the minor's selection of materials.

Tarjeta de la Biblioteca de Alsip-Merrionette Park Public Library esta disponible para residentes de Alsip, Garden Homes y Merrionette Park

Opcion 1) Se les pide a los solicitantes o padres/tutores legales (si el solicitante es menor de 18 años) que mostrar una identificación con foto que indique su nombre y dirección actual. Además, se le pide que muestre otra forma de identificación con el mismo nombre y dirección actual de los artículos preaprobados que se enumeran a continuación.

Opcion 2) Si la identificación con foto no contiene una dirección de distrito actual, entonces dos (2) se deben presentar otros artículos que contengan el mismo nombre y dirección del distrito.

La lista preaprobada incluye:

Factura de servicios públicos
Arrendar
Libro de Pago de Hipoteca
Registro actual de la etiqueta del vehículo
Identificación de registro de vehículo actual
Tarjeta de seguro de automóvil
Credencial de elector
Identificación de armas de fuego actual
Declaración médica del estado actual de Illinois
Horario actual del semestre universitario

Todos los artículos deben estar actualizados y mostrar una dirección del distrito. Tenga en cuenta: los límites del distrito de bibliotecas y de nuestros distritos escolares no son los mismos..

Los usuarios de Chicago con una tarjeta CPL válida pueden solicitar una tarjeta reciproca de biblioteca en AMP. La tarjeta proporciona privilegios de préstamo limitados, según lo establecido por la Biblioteca Pública de Chicago.

Las personas que deseen una tarjeta de la biblioteca para ellos o para sus hijos deben proporcionar información personal para ingresar electrónicamente en línea junto con una firma electrónica que acepta lo siguiente:

- 1) ser responsable de todos los materiales prestados en la tarjeta;
- 2) ser responsable de cualquier cargo (incluidos los honorarios de la agencia de cobro) que pueda resultar de la devolución tardía, la pérdida o el daño a materiales prestados;
- 3) para cumplir con las regulaciones de la biblioteca local y del Sistema de Bibliotecas Reaching Across Illinois (RAILS)

En el caso de un menor de 18 años, también se requiere la firma del padre/madre/tutor legal. Esta firma indica:

- 1) responsabilidad económica por los materiales prestados en la tarjeta del menor;
- 2) conocimiento del hecho de que no hay restricciones para tomar prestado cualquier material de la biblioteca EXCEPTO materiales audiovisuales;
- 3) aceptación de la responsabilidad de la selección de materiales por parte del menor
