CLASSROOM HAPPENINGS

In March, we spent the first week reading several Pete the Cat books, which were featured for Reading Night. The children loved listening to the adventures of Pete and his friends. We made our bulletin board after the book *Pete the Cat and His Four Groovy Buttons* and each student painted a button to decorate our board.

We also worked on our St. Patrick's Day theme in March. We went on a gold hunt around the classroom and found different letters hidden on each piece of gold. We practiced our counting skills by counting gold coins and matching them to numbers. We also made a rainbow using Skittles and water - the children were so excited to watch the rainbow form! We even had a visit from a leprechaun, who left a big mess in our classroom! We also introduced our Spring theme last month. We used watercolors to paint umbrellas and we made Fruit Loop rainbows.

This month we began working on our new study, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. We began talking about what the students know and they had some great insight into ways we could reuse certain items!
