

PRESCHOOL FOR ALL NEWSLETTER DECEMBER 2020



How is it December already? Even though November was a short month, we did a lot in the time we had together. We continued working on our tree study and we learned about the animals that lived in trees. We made up math stories using a nest and eggs and counted how many eggs were in and out of the nest. We discussed different animals that lived in trees and water and we worked on sorting animals based on their habitat.

We also worked on some Thanksgiving activities. We experimented with some fall items to see which items would sink and which would float when placed in a bowl of water. We were all surprised to learn that the heavy pumpkin floated when placed in the water! We practiced our counting skills by rolling a die and counting the number of "whipped cream dollops" (cotton balls) we put on our pumpkin pie. We also incorporated fine motor skills into this task by using tongs to place the cotton balls onto the pie.

While December looks a little different, we will still be working hard. We will finish working on our Tree study with some counting and patterning activities using a Christmas tree. We will also work on some letter activities and end the month working on our favorite project of the year, gingerbread houses!
