<u>THEME:</u> We finished working on our unit based on the story *Is Your Mama a Llama?* We also worked on our dental health theme this week.

<u>CONCEPTS INTRODUCED</u>: We introduced the letter Q this week. We worked on snipping skills and color matching. We tried answering who, what and where questions about the story and reviewed matching mama and baby animals.

<u>CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES</u>: We painted the letter Q using Q-tips. We did an experiment to see how important it is to brush teeth.
