We also enjoyed turning into insects and making bug movements around the classroom. We were very interested in watching our caterpillars grow and make their transformation into butterflies.

During the month of May, we will be finishing our Insect theme. We will discuss the questions "Where do insects live?" and "What insects are in our community?". We will practice our visual discrimination skills with a bug memory game and we will practice graphing our favorite bugs. We will enjoy a lot of time outside and we look forward to some fun-filled activities, such as field day and our end of the year celebration!
