CLASSROOM HAPPENINGS

In October, we began working on our Balls study and we examined the questions “What do we know about balls?”, “Will all balls bounce?” and “Do all balls roll?”. We sorted objects by sound, we made a graph and tallied our favorite balls and we made predictions and counted how many times different balls would bounce. We also dug in sand to find buried treasure (shapes).

We also worked on some Halloween activities during the month of October. We did a fun experiment where we dissolved candy pumpkins in different liquids and we practiced counting with one-to-one correspondence using spiders. The students had a great time at the Palos Children’s Farm and it was so wonderful to see everyone’s artistic skills shine when they decorated their pumpkins at our parent event. We also enjoyed our Halloween parade and celebration!

While it is a short month, November will be very busy. We will continue working on our Balls study and will investigate the questions “What makes balls move?” and “Who uses balls?”. We are looking forward to our Music Playhouse program later this month. We will also spend some time talking about Thanksgiving and the things for which we are thankful.
