THEME: We continued working on our unit based on the story *I Love You*. We also finished working on our Valentine's Day theme this week.

CONCEPTS INTRODUCED: We reviewed our letters and numbers this week. We practiced counting and using one to one correspondence.

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES: We sponge-painted hearts and worked on fine motor skills with different Valentine's Day centers. We counted and strung beads and we hammered pegs onto a heart. We made valentines by spinning paint in a salad spinner and we made love bugs. We will also begin working on creating our own *I Love You* books to bring home at the end of our unit (since our book is out of print, the children will be making their own books).
