What we are learning this month:

Reading- Our first two themes were the importance of friendship and the importance of Family. The read alouds led to great discussions on how families care for each other and the characteristics of a good friend.

Phonics Word Study- We have been tapping out sounds for c-v-c words (consonant, vowel, consonant) and are now blending words with digraphs-wh,th,sh,ck,ch. We are also looking at rhyming words.

Math- We are finishing up Theme 1 which included counting and comparing groups and solving word problems. In Theme 2 we will be focusing on geometry and composing and decomposing 2D shapes.

Science- We are beginning our animal unit. The first group we will be focusing on our mammals. We will learn the characteristics of all mammals. We will discover whether animals are carnivores or herbivores through hands on activities.
