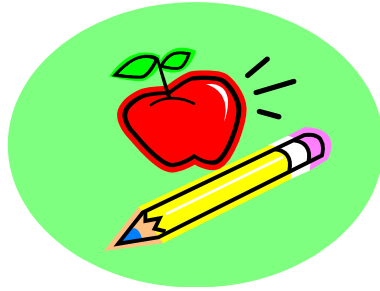

Homework

Homework will generally include studying spelling words, reading, and math. Writing journals will be sent home on a weekly basis starting late September/early October. Your child should have their homework written on their assignment sheet each day, and it must be returned to school the following morning. Thank you for checking that homework is completed.

Reading

Our first reading theme will be "The Importance of Friendship", a great start to our school year! Our comprehension focus will be on strategies such as predicting, summarizing, understanding sequence, and identifying main characters.

Math

Our introduction to Math will focus on the proper classroom use of hands-on math tools such as connecting cubes, counters, and geometric shapes. We will begin learning how to build numbers in different ways and how to compare numbers.

Spelling

Our first spelling test will be September 2nd. Our first few spelling tests will be a review of previously taught sounds and concepts and 2 common sight words. Spelling words will be sent home on Monday and tests will be given on Friday. Please practice studying the spelling words with your child each night so they can feel confident on the day of the test.

Reminders

Our gym days are Thursday and Friday – your child must have gym shoes! Also, if you choose to send a treat for your child's birthday, it must be an individually wrapped item such as a fruit snack, granola bar, or rice krispie treat. Please don't send cupcakes!
